Sandy Moore has volunteered for Membership Director.

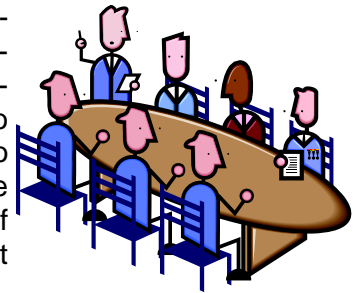
We are also looking for a volunteer for Treasurer to fill out the remainder of Everett's term.

San Juan Cruise 2009



October 17 – 25, 2009

It's hard to believe but it's very close to time for the final payment for the San Juan Cruise. We are currently working to get the airfare locked in and the prices are looking good. We should have a definite price for everyone by next month.

In order to secure our spots, we will need to be sending in deposits for airfare, hotels, etc. In order to do that we need to know for sure how many people are serious about going. If you have made a payment on the San Juan Cruise and are serious about going, **I need you to have put down at least \$500 per person by March 31.** In order to plan correctly for this trip, I need to know exactly how many cabins are going to be filled and if we have any cabins we can return back to the cruise company. I also have some people who are on a waiting list for balcony cabins and we need to know if there will be any available. **If you have not put down at least \$500 by March 31 I will assume you are not serious about going and could possibly give your room away to someone else.**

Remember, this cruise will begin with the first day and evening at The Caribe Hilton in San Juan, it is one of the most luxurious resorts in Puerto Rico, with oceanfront swimming pools, whirlpools and hammocks next to the secluded beach. The next morning we will be whisked away on the cruise ship for stops Barbados, St. Thomas, Dominica, St. Kitts and Dominican Republic.

The prices listed below could still fluctuate until we have the airline locked in and are based upon double occupancy. Single cruisers may possibly be matched up with other cruisers from other clubs if they are available, otherwise there could be a higher single cruise rate.

February Meeting at Snow Trails—Recap

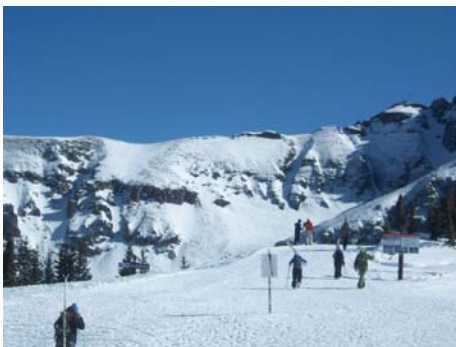
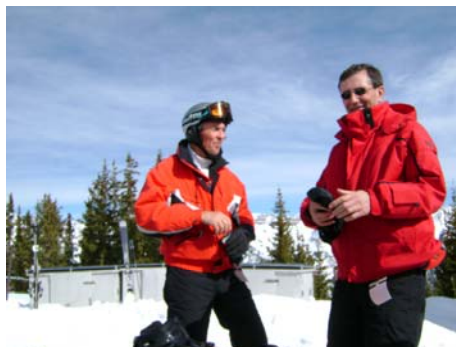

Thanks to the many members who came out to help show our support to Snow Trails.

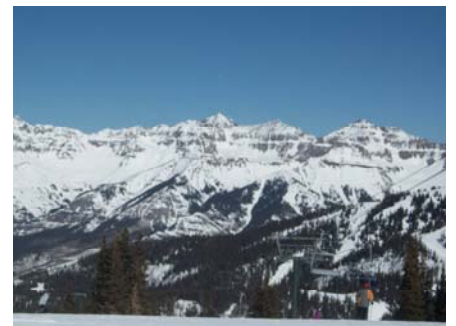
