It's time to Vote Again! (AKA Where to Ski 2010)

At the March meeting the membership was presented with two different options for skiing in 2010. (Breckenridge, CO and Park City, Utah) After the information was presented, it was voted on by a show of hands that most of the club was interested in Breckenridge.



I have recently heard some feedback that there may be more people interested in Utah than what was represented at the meeting. Several people have expressed that they could not be at the meeting, but would definitely be interested in going to Utah, but not to Breckenridge. As you know, we are a small club and can only support one western trip per year, so we need to make a decision. So now is your time to cast your vote.

Voting will be done by putting down a \$25 (refundable at this point) deposit on the trip that you are interested in. Cuyahoga Valley National Park
June 19 – 20, 2009**

We have sold out all spots on the wine train. If you are interested in going and have not already made your payment please contact me, it is possible we can get more spots. But I need to hear from you ASAP!

Remember this is a trip on a vintage train car in the beautiful Cuyahoga Valley National park. While being served 5 different wines from Ferrante Winery in Geneva, Ohio, along with light appetizers, you can peer through the windows and enjoy the breath taking view. You might catch a glimpse of white tailed deer, blue heron hunting in the Cuyahoga River, families enjoying a hike along the Ohio & Erie Towpath Trail, and historic buildings that hold within their frames stories of those who have called this valley home.

For \$129 per person (based upon double occupancy) you can enjoy not only coach seating on the 2 hour trip through the park, but also overnight accommodations at the Clarion Hotel in Hudson, \$30 voucher (per couple) towards dinner, transportation to and from the train, and a buffet breakfast on Saturday morning!
