**October 17 – 25, 2009**

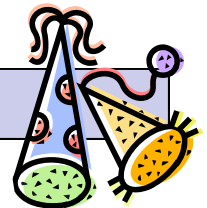

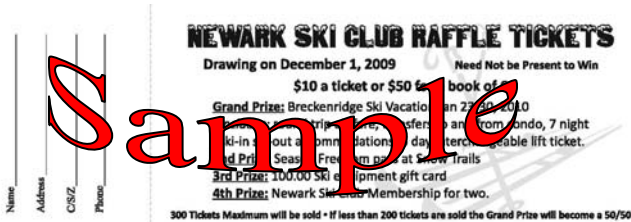
